Your space is 4 ft wide and 4 ft long, allowing space for your 2ft x 4 ft table, and one or two chairs.

SET UP HOURS: 8 am to 10 am. Show hours are from 10-4 Everyone must check in at the registration table in front of the Gazebo, on Saturday before 10:00 am.

Please check in with our registration desk at the Gazebo stage.

RESERVE YOUR SPOT: If you are a participant, I will email you the event layout. Please reply to reserve your preferred spot. We will set the places as your replies are received on a first come, first served basis.

PARKING AND ACCESS: The event will be held in the gazebo area on Brevard Avenue in Cocoa Village. Event staff will endeavor to keep the loading zone on the west side of the square clear, so that participants may unload before parking. Access time will be very limited here due to the number of participants. We suggest parking in the main Village lot on the north side of Stone Street.
