May the holidays bring peace, love, and joy to your characters this season.

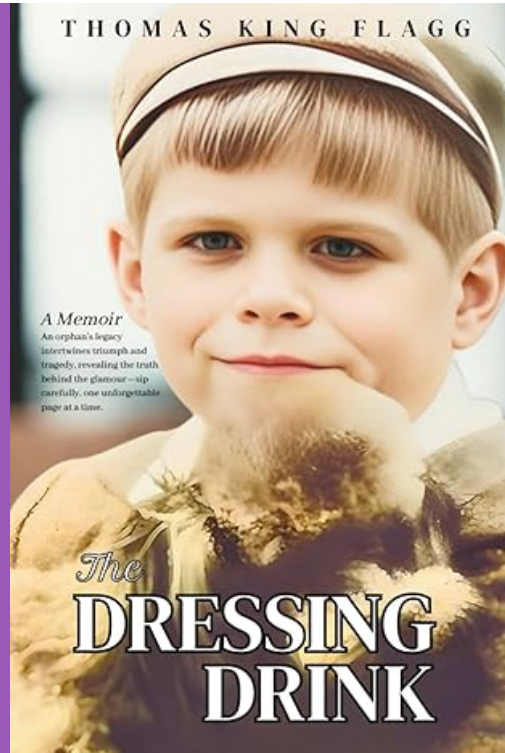


### SILLY MUSE
